### County Attorney Strandlie honored by Minn. Lawyer magazine

Cass County Attorney Christopher Strandlie was honored May 11 by Minnesota Lawyer magazine as a 2011 Up and Coming Attorney, at an awards luncheon at the Hyatt Regency Hotel in downtown Minneapolis.

Each year, Minnesota Lawyer honors a group of lawyers who have distinguished themselves in their legal careers. The 27 honorees came from private practice, government work and in-house legal departments and were nominated by members of the Minnesota legal community.

The criteria considered for the award included professional accomplishment, leadership service to the community and to the profession. Strandlie was the only county attorney selected for this honor and one of three attorneys practicing outside the Metro area.

Strandlie presently serves on the Board of Directors for several area nonprofit organizations, including the Family Advocacy Center of Northern Minnesota, the Working Together Coalition and the Leech Lake Youth Hockey Association. He is a Walker Fire Department volunteer, a member of the American Legion and a past member of the Walker Chamber of Commerce Board, the Walker School Board and the Walker Rotary Club.
